


VIEWSHEET- A COMPUTER BASED SPREADSHEET

Designed for use by the beginner and the professional, ViewSheet will help you with business applications – cash flow forecasts, sales analysis or resource planning – and with personal finances such as housekeeping budgets or investment projections.

ViewSheet saves you having to carry out repetitive calculations

Imagine a blank grid, 255 columns wide and 255 rows deep, of which you see just one part on your screen at a time. You fill in your spreadsheet on this grid, just as you would with pencil and paper. Enter numbers and provide the formula you would normally use; ViewSheet checks all the figures that the formula applies to and carries out the calculations automatically.

As you fill in the spreadsheet you may find that you want to look at two separate sets of information together, but which are in completely different areas of the spreadsheet. In this case, you can define these parts of the spreadsheet as 'windows', and look at them on the screen at the same time. In fact, ViewSheet's unique facility allows you to view up to ten windows at any one time, for maximum convenience.

ViewSheet is especially flexible and powerful

A major advantage of a spreadsheet system is its ability to look at different possibilities—a 'what if' feature. What if sales go up by 10 per cent this year? What if we increase our mortgage payments by £50 a month? You can enter any number of variations and ViewSheet will automatically recalculate and produce the revised results.

ViewSheet will recognise values, formulae and labels or headings. Values can be formatted in any way you wish, with up to nine decimal places, pounds and pence and left or right justified. A special feature of ViewSheet is that you can replace the row and column numbers with headings, so that it is much easier to refer to areas of the spreadsheet.

Special disc files can be created to link two or more spreadsheets together. This allows you to build models much larger than the computer's memory.

You can print the entire worksheet or select any number of windows from it and arrange them as you want them to appear on the print-out. Special effects such as bold and underline can be achieved using the Printer Driver

Generator. You can combine ViewSheet files with VIEW files to produce reports, for example, complete with tables of figures.

'Slots' where each item of information is stored as either a label, a value or a formula

Use formulae to tell the system which calculations to carry out; View Sheet operations include addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, exponentiation and bracketed operations

Select format options for number of decimal places, left or right hand justification; select global format or a slot at a time

'Windows' allow you to look at parts of a worksheet much larger than the screen; with ViewSheet you can look at up to ten windows at one time and scroll them in any direction

Column and row headings can be used instead of letters and numbers, for more easily understood references

Range of standard functions includes ABS, ACS, ASN, ATN, COS, DEG, LN, INT, EXP, PI, RAD, SIN, SGN, SQR, TAN, MAX, MIN, AVERAGE, CHOOSE, LOOKUP, IF, ROW, COL


