How the Course Tutor Is Used



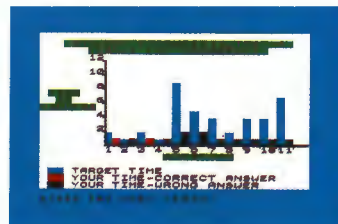
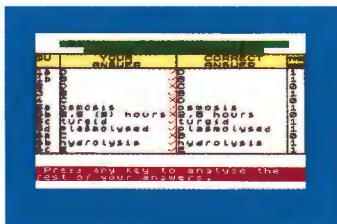
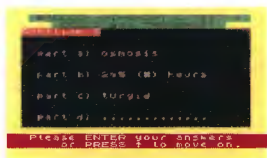
Diagnostic Tests

The student may attempt the *Test Paper* provided for each section of the syllabus. He or she enters the answer to each question into the computer. When the paper is completed, the *Diagnostic Software* displays marks scored and an individual report on the student's performance.

3 Displays the time taken for each question (alongside the optimum target time)



Screen 4 (not shown here) — a detailed report on further work required.

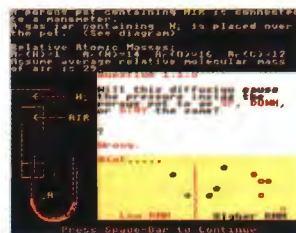
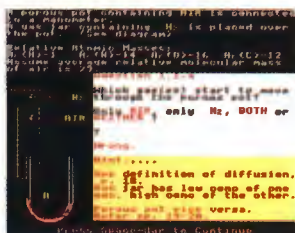
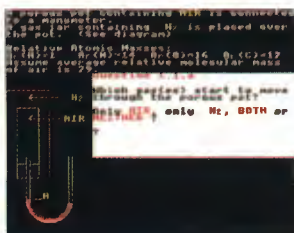
Learning Modules
