Acorn's BBC Model B Emulator for the A3000 and Archimedes range runs version 1.20 of the Machine Operating System of the BBC Model B, so even the few known bugs in the Model B's Operating System are faithfully reproduced!

### FOR ARCHIMEDES USERS

You can use the BBC Model B Emulator to help you transfer and run software written for the BBC Model B on the BBC A3000, the Archimedes range or any other computer with RISC OS, provided that you are legally entitled to do so.

Many applications that run on the BBC Master 128 also run on the Model B, so the Model B Emulator provides a bridge of continuity between the 6502-based range of Acorn computers and the ARM-based range of Acorn RISC computers.

### FOR SOFTWARE DEVELOPERS

You can use the BBC Model B Emulator to help port and version your existing 6502-based applications for RISC OS, and as a Registered Developer you can obtain a licence from Acorn to incorporate the emulator in your products.

All the issues involved in this process are covered in the supporting *User Guide*, which includes a comprehensive Technical Reference section.

Registered Developers may purchase full BBC Model B Emulator packs, including disc and printed manual. Details and voucher are obtainable from Acorn's ISV Department.

### HOW TO ORDER

LEA authorities have been provided with master copies of BBC Model B Emulator and permission to duplicate it for use within educational establishments, so if you want to use it in a school or college, contact your LEA or local IT centre.

If you subscribe to SID (Acorn's Support Information Database), you can 'download' the BBC Model B Emulator software, which includes an electronic version of the *User Guide* which you can read on your computer screen or copy to a printer.

# **TECHNICAL INFORMATION**

BBC Model B Emulator provides a software bridge between the 6502 based range of Acorn computers (the BBC Model B, B+, Master 128, Master Compact and Electron) and the RISC OS environment of the BBC A3000 and Archimedes computers.

It consists of an emulator of the BBC Model B environment, utilities and examples to help port existing 6502-based software to RISC OS and a comprehensive User Guide.

## !65Host

Enhanced version of the Model B environment emulator.

## !65Tube

Emulates a 65C02 second processor.

### **BBC**scan

Utility which searches through a 6502-based BASIC program, highlighting potential problem areas for running the code 'native' on RISC OS.

## DFSConv

Utility for converting DFS directory structures into the format required on an ADFS disc for running under the emulator.

## PicConv

Utility which converts BBC screen files into **RISC OS sprites.** 

# *UdgConv*

Utility which converts user-defined graphics characters for the BBC Model B into BASIC VDU statements for incorporation into a program.

Simple example of a program written for a 6502-based computer.

The example modified to run 'native' on RISC OS.
