The four stated aims of the book are:

- 1) to give further explanation of the basic functions of Wordwise,
- 2) to offer solutions to the various problems which people have experienced in using Wordwise, (This is based not only on the author's own considerable experience, but also on a list of questions which people have asked Computer Concepts.)
- 3) to offer various hints and tips picked up by the author having used Wordwise extensively for more than two years,
- 4) to suggest a wide range of possible applications for Wordwise, some involving the use of BASIC in conjunction with Wordwise.

Applications and programs include: Alphabetic list creation program; Writing and editing BASIC programs in Wordwise; Program to add special effects to your printer, including auto-underlining, Automatic multiple copy printing program, Exchanging files with View, and Typesetting from disc files. The book is 100 pages A4, 30,000+ words, has 10 chapters, a contents list, a full index and 6 appendices including Printer code information, Additional information about Wordwise 1.2 and a Greek/scientific character set for the Epson FX80.
