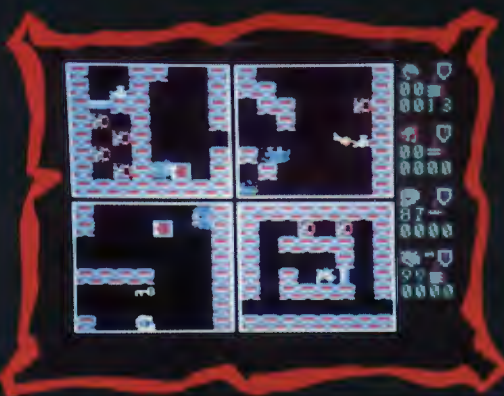

Since we last met in London the wheel has turned full circle for Acorn. After two years of troubled trading conditions the company has bounced back into the black with an operating profit of £1.4 million and a 38

per cent increase in sales.

This is gratifying news for everyone connected with the growing family of BBC and Electron computers.

But even during Acorn's difficult times, success of the Electron & BBC Micro User Show was always assured due to the unfailing loyalty of the machines' massive user base.

Thank you for your consistent support, and enjoy yourself today.

# What a difference a year makes . . .

### May 1986:

The booming Electron market led to the creation of more than 100 new jobs by third party suppliers. Companies reported they were being stretched to the limit by demands for add-ons and software.

### June 1986:

West Glamorgan County Council spent £250,000 to provide its comprehensive schools with Master 128 micros. A spokesman for Acorn said: "This is one of the most significant deals in the history of Acorn. It proves we have a solid future ahead of us".

### July 1986:

Production of the Master 128 was increased to 50,000 machines a month but Acorn still could not meet demand. A survey revealed that the company could be selling 100,000 machines every four weeks.

### August 1986:

A new 20Mb Winchester disc drive was announced by Acorn. A spokesman said: "It is a very reliable Winchester, well tested and with after sales warranty".

### September 1986:

Co-founder Chris Curry left the

board of Acorn in order to work more closely with his own company General Information Systems which markets Acorn's Communicator workstation.

### October 1986:

The 128k Compact was unveiled. Featuring a built-in disc drive the machine carried a price tag of £399. "We see the Compact as the ideal family machine in that it offers something for everybody", said Jeremy Preston, Acorn's marketing communications manager.

### November 1986:

Acorn announced an operating profit of £298,000 for the first six months of the year and said it was looking forward to "a new era of prosperity".

### December 1986:

For the first time ever Father Christmas came on-line from the North Pole. Equipped with a BBC Micro he was able to answer messages transmitted via the MicroLink electronic mail service.

### January 1987:

The price of the 512k add-on board was slashed by £200 to £199. This was Acorn's first move in a campaign to

ensure that Amstrad did not have it all its own way in the small business market.

### February 1987:

An order from Poland for nearly £1 million worth of hardware and software was won by Acorn. The deal involved 200 Master 128 and 1,500 Compact machines, plus disc drives and monitors.

### March 1987:

Another major order was clinched by the company. The Hong Kong government purchased 700 Master 128s.

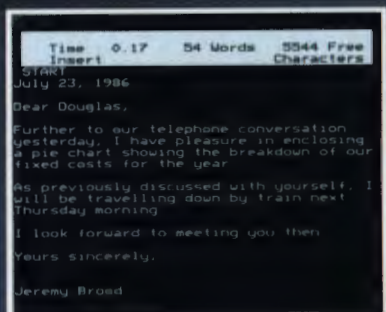
### April 1987:

Three new appointments to the board of Acorn were announced. Paolo Tosi and Franco Agostinucci were appointed directors and Olivetti's vice president for product strategy became chairman of the board.

### May 1987:

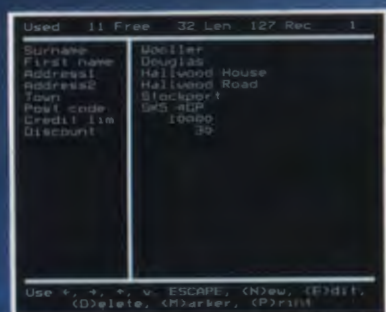
Details of a new super-fast range of 32 bit machines were announced by the company. Reported to be seven times faster than any micro currently available the machines are based on the revolutionary RISC chip.

Nor will it function correctly if you experience interference such as ghosting. They emphasise that these problems only affect a few areas of the country. However, if you have any doubts as to the quality of signal available in your area you should contact the BBC Technical Support Service on 01-927 5040.

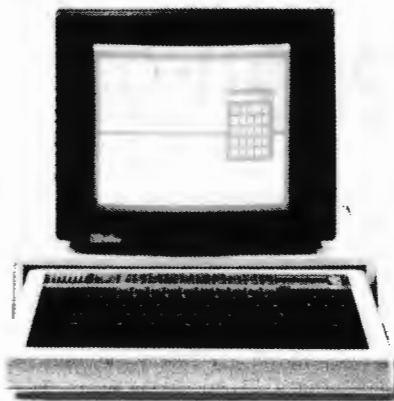

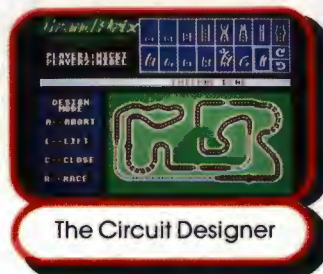
